The 23/24 season is now complete for Suffolk using a total of 60 players (34 men, 26 ladies) across 5 teams and 27 matches. With numbers growing in the Over 40s age group, we were able to sustain 2 teams for the second season and conceded just the last match of the season.

Huge thanks go to the 40s and 50s squad captains Steve Lambert and Alan Jones for all their efforts in leading their squads and to Alice Sim, Lisa Lee and Lisa Jacobs for their work with their teams across the season and to everyone who has been part of Suffolk's Masters 23/4 season – players and supporters alike. The season has not been without its injury challenges including some long term ones – we hope to welcome everyone back next season fresh and ready for action, along with some newcomers already recruited for the Over 40s, 50s and 65s.
